Chiltern Hundreds Charity Run

In aid of Bucks Vision, Visual Impairment Charity (Registered Charity No. 203345)

Burnham Cricket Club, Burnham, Slough, SL1 8LP. Sunday 17th July 2011, 10.00am

VENUE: The event will start and finish at Burnham Cricket Club, Taplow Common Road, Burnham, SL1 8LP.

SIGNING ON: Signing on will be from 9.00am. Entrants must report to the registration area in the clubhouse prior to commencing the run. A numbered card will be provided which must be displayed on the front of your motorcycle.

START TIME: The run will start at 10.00am. Riders will all leave together led by a 'Run Leader' and a 'Drop-off Marshal' who will both be riding classic, Class B, motorcycles. The run will be self-marshalled using the 'drop-off' system, which will be explained in the final instructions.

PARKING: There will be no public parking provision for cars or trailers at the start. Competitors wishing to trailer their bike to the start must find their own parking away from the start area.

BREAKDOWNS: No recovery will be provided and it will be down to the individual rider to make their own breakdown recovery arrangements. An emergency contact number will be provided for notification of any other problems en-route.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to anyone of the legal age to ride a motorcycle. Riders must be in possession of a current driving licence and all motorcycles must be fully roadworthy with a current tax disc, insurance and MOT certificate. It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure their vehicle meets the above requirements.

ENTRIES: Entries must be on this official form and sent to the Event Secretary together with the fee of £10.00 for riders and £6.00 each for passengers, plus a stamped addressed envelope. Cheques and Postal Orders should be made payable to: AMOC East Berks. All funds from this event will be donated to Bucks Vision (Registered Charity No. 203345). Entries close 11th July 2011 or when the entry has reached 100 riders. Entries received after the close date or when the maximum entry limit has been reached will be returned at the entrant's expense. Note: There will be no entries on the day unless the entry limit has not been reached, in which case an entry fee of £15 will be charged.

THE ROUTE: The route will be approximately 75 miles long on minor public roads. There will be a mid-point stop for refreshments and toilets during the run.

CLASSES: Class A: Any machine manufactured prior to 1945. Class B: Any machine manufactured from 1946 to 1971.
Class C: Any machine manufactured from 1972 to 1984. Class D: Any machine manufactured from 1984-on.
Class E: Any sidecar.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented for the best turned out machines in classes A to E.
